**The Import (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order,
2015**

Coming into operation

17th March, 2015

THE HOME DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946^a and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

Amendments to Order of 2010.

1. Schedule 6A to the Import (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 2010^b is amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph 2 of the Schedule, the following paragraphs -

"3. Any medicinal product that -

(a) is, or purports to be, GcMAF, or

(b) contains, or purports to contain, GcMAF.

4. In paragraph 3, "medicinal product" has the meaning given to that expression by paragraphs 5 and 6 of Schedule 3 to this Order."

Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Order, a reference to any enactment is a reference to the enactment as from time to time amended, varied, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

(2) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c apply to the interpretation of this Order as they apply to the interpretation of an enactment.

Citation.

3. This Order may be cited as the Import (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 2015.

Commencement.

4. This Order comes into force on the 17th March, 2015.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Import (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 2010 ("the **principal Order**").

Currently, the importation of any medicinal product is prohibited subject to the exceptions specified in Schedule 3 to the principal Order. As available information indicates that medicinal products that are or contain GcMAF may pose a significant risk to human health, the exceptions provided for in Schedule 3 are considered to be

inappropriate for those products.

This Order inserts a new paragraph 3 in Schedule 6A (specific substances, etc. of concern) to the principal Order, in order to specifically prohibit the importation of any medicinal product that is, purports to be, contains or purports to contain GcMAF. This Order also inserts a new paragraph 4 in that schedule to define "**medicinal product**" by reference to the meaning given to that expression by paragraphs 5 and 6 of Schedule 3 (medicinal products) to the principal Order. The only exception to this import prohibition is if the importation of the product is authorised by an import licence granted by the Home Department under the principal Order.

This Order comes into force on the 17th March, 2015.
