The Public Vehicles (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 1988

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 2nd day of March, 1988, hereby order: –

Transfer of Functions.

1. ...

NOTE

Section 1 was repealed by the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways (Amendment) Ordinance, 1992, section 2, with effect from 2nd September, 1992, subject to the continuing savings in section 3 of the 1992 Ordinance.¹

Consequential amendments.

2. In consequence of the transfer of functions effected by section 1 of this Ordinance, the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways Ordinance, 1966 is amended as follows –

(a) ...

(b) in section 35(1), the words "made by the Committee" are repealed,²

(c) in section 35(2), the words "by the Committee" are repealed,³

(2) This Ordinance and the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways Ordinances, 1966 and 1986 may be cited together as the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways Ordinances, 1966 and 1988.

Commencement.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on 1st April, 1988.
