**The Liquor Licensing (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2015***Made*15<sup>th</sup> June 2015*Coming into operation*15<sup>th</sup> June, 2015*Laid before the States*

**THE HOME DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 84(4) and 99 of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

**Amendment of fees.**

1. The Fourth Schedule to the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006, is amended in accordance with the Schedule to these Regulations.

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise, -

"**enactment**" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation,

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect,

and other words and expressions shall have the same meanings as in the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006.

(2) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law 1948<sup>b</sup> shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as they apply to the interpretation of an enactment.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to any enactment is a reference to the enactment as from time to time amended, replaced, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

**Revocation.**

3. The Liquor Licensing (Fees) Regulations, 2015<sup>c</sup> are hereby revoked.

**Extent.**

4. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

**Commencement and Citation.**

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2015 and shall come into force on the 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2015.
