**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Order,  
2015**

*23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2015*

*Coming into operation*

*5<sup>th</sup> July, 2015*

**THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended<sup>a</sup>, hereby orders:-

**Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.**

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, is further amended as follows -

- (a) immediately after paragraph 1 in Part VIII of Schedule 1, insert the following paragraph -

"2. Longue Hougue Lane. This paragraph applies to all vehicles and animals, except for access to premises on Longue Hougue Lane.",

- (b) immediately after after the words "East to West" in column 2 of paragraph 1B of Part VII of Schedule 2, insert the words ", except a cyclist riding or pushing a bicycle within a marked cycle contraflow lane.", and

- (c) immediately after the words "West to East" in column 2 of paragraph 8A of Part VII of Schedule 2, insert the words ", except a cyclist riding or pushing a bicycle within a marked cycle contraflow lane."

**Interpretation.**

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>b</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

**Repeals.**

3. The Traffic Temporary (Longue Hougue Lane) Regulations, 2014<sup>c</sup> and the Traffic Temporary (Le Bordage Road and Oatlands Lane) Regulations, 2014<sup>d</sup> are hereby repealed.

**Citation**

4. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Order, 2015.

**Commencement**

5. This Order shall come into force on the 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2015.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

The purpose of this Order is to amend the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, by making permanent the traffic experiments that restrict vehicular and animal access to Longue Hougue Lane except for access to premises therein, and permit cyclists to ride or push their bicycles against the one-way systems in operation at Le Bordage Road and Oatlands Lane providing the cyclist is doing so within the marked contra-flow lane. This Order comes into force on the 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2015.
