

ORDER IN COUNCIL.



IN THE ROYAL COURT OF THE ISLAND OF GUERNSEY.

The 10th day of July, 1948, before Ambrose James Sherwill, Esquire, C.B.E., M.C., Bailiff; present : Osmond Priaulx Gallienne, Esquire, Sir John Leale, Knight, James Frederick Carey, Arthur Falla, Pierre de Putron, Quertier Le Pelley, Walter John Sarre, Esquires, Richard Henry Johns, Esquire, O.B.E., Walter John Gavey and Ernest Francis Lainé, Esquires, Jurats.

The Bailiff having this day placed before the Court an Order of His Majesty in Council dated the 22nd day of June, 1948, ratifying a *Projet de Loi* entitled "Law authorising Increases in the Rates of certain Duties, Impôts and Taxes, 1948",—the Court, after the reading of the said Order in Council and after having heard His Majesty's Procureur, ordered that the said Order in Council be registered on the Records of this Island, of which *Projet de Loi* the tenor followeth :—

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Report from the Right Honourable the Lords of the Committee of Council for the Affairs of Guernsey and Jersey, dated the 4th day of June, 1948, in the words following, viz.:—

“YOUR MAJESTY having been pleased, by Your General Order of Reference of the 18th day of December, 1936, to refer unto this Committee the humble Petition of the States of the Island of Guernsey, setting forth:—

‘1.—That, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 17th day of December, 1947, the States of Deliberation at a meeting held on the 4th day of February, 1948, approved a Bill or “Projet de Loi” entitled “Law authorising Increases in the Rates of certain Duties, Impôts and Taxes, 1948” and requested the Bailiff to present a most humble Petition to Your Majesty in Council praying for Your Royal Sanction thereto: 2.—That the said Bill or “Projet de Loi” is in the words and figures set forth in the Schedule herunto annexed. And most humbly praying that Your Majesty might be graciously pleased to grant Your Royal Sanction to the Bill or “Projet de Loi” of the States of Guernsey entitled “Law authorising Increases in the Rates of certain Duties, Impôts and Taxes, 1948”, and to order and direct that the same shall have force of Law in the Island of Guernsey.’

“THE LORDS OF THE COMMITTEE, in obedience to Your Majesty’s said Order of Reference, have taken the said Petition and the said Projet de Loi into consideration, and do this day agree humbly to report, as their opinion, to Your Majesty, that it may be advisable for Your Majesty to comply with the prayer of the said Petition and to approve of and ratify the said Projet de Loi.”

HIS MAJESTY having taken the said Report into consideration is pleased, by and with advice of His Privy Council, to approve of and ratify the said Projet

de Loi, and to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the same shall have the force of Law within the Island of Guernsey.

AND HIS MAJESTY doth hereby further direct that this Order, and the said *Projet de Loi* (a copy whereof is hereunto annexed) be entered upon the Register of the Island of Guernsey and observed accordingly.

AND the Lieutenant Governor or Commander-in-Chief of the Island of Guernsey, the Bailiff and Jurats, and all other His Majesty's Officers, for the time being, in the said Island, and all other persons whom it may concern, are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

PROJET DE LOI

ENTITLED

**“Law authorising Increases in the Rates of
certain Duties, Impôts and Taxes, 1948.”**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 17th day of December, 1947, have approved the following provisions which, subject to the Sanction of His Most Excellent Majesty in Council, shall have force of law in this Island.

The States may, by Resolution, increase by an amount not exceeding fifty per centum thereof the rate at which the several Duties, Impôts and Taxes mentioned in the Schedule to this Law were leviable on the 31st day of December, 1947.

SCHEDULE.

The Stamp Duties, or any of them.

The Impôts on (a) Beer

(b) Cider

(c) Matches

(d) Spirits

(e) Wines.

The Tax on Rental Values.

The Tax on Entertainments.
