THE POLICY COUNCIL, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 5 of the Fees, Charges and Penalties (Guernsey) Law, 2007^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

Amendment of fees for grant or renewal of bornement.

1. In paragraph (a) of Article 36(2A) of the Ordinance entitled *Ordonnance ayant rapport à la Construction de Maisons, Salles Publiques et Bâtiments, et au Tracement de Route et Chemins, 1931^b*, for "£15" substitute "£25".

Citation.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Bornement (Fees), Regulations, 2015.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on 1st September, 2015.
