

**Ordonnance relative à l'usage des machines dites " Slot Machines " et aux Paris.**

La Cour, vu l'approbation des États, ouïes les conclusions des Officiers du Roi, a renouvelé comme Ordonnance permanente les dispositions de l'Ordonnance provisoire relative à l'usage des machines dites " Slot Machines " et aux Paris, passée le 2 juin 1928, de laquelle Ordonnance la teneur suit :—

La Cour, ouïes les conclusions des Officiers du Roi, a adopté les règlements suivants rédigés en anglais ayant rapport à l'usage des machines dites "Slot Machines" et aux Paris.

1. Any person who in this Island

- (1) sets up and exposes for use by other Slot machines. persons any slot machine or other mechanical or automatic device the action of which is controlled by the insertion of a coin or token, otherwise than for the purpose of the purchase of an ascertained article of service or value, or
- (2) writes, prints, publishes or knowingly sells, circulates or distributes any advertisement, circular ticket, token or coupon of any ready money betting business, whether such

business is carried on in this Island or elsewhere, or who knowingly causes or procures, or attempts to cause or procure, any of those things to be done, or knowingly assists therein,

Penalty. shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £10, or in case of a second or subsequent conviction, to a fine not exceeding £100, and further in the case of an offence under the preceding subsection to the confiscation of such machine or device.

Penalty for employment of children under 16 years of age.

2. Any person who employs, procures or induces a child under the age of sixteen years to sell, circulate or distribute any of the matters mentioned in section (2) of the preceding article shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £10.

Penalty for opening, using house, office, room or place for doing any acts described in Art. 1.

3. Any person who being the owner or occupier or having the use of any house, office, room or place shall open, keep or use or shall knowingly and wilfully permit the same to be opened, kept or used by any other person for the purpose of doing any of the acts or things described in article I of this Ordinance shall, on summary conviction, be liable to the penalties provided therein.

Definition of "ready money betting business."

4. The expression "ready money betting business" in this Ordinance means any business or agency for the making of ready money bets or wagers, or for the receipt of any money or valuable thing as the consideration for a bet or wager in connection with any game or sport.
