**The Driving Licences (Guernsey) Theory Test  
(Amendment) Regulations, 2015**

*Made* 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2015  
*Coming into operation* 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2016

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 4A of the Driving Licences (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1995 as amended<sup>a</sup>, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

**Amendments to the 2005 Regulations.**

1. (1) The Driving Licences (Guernsey) Theory Test Regulations, 2005, as amended<sup>b</sup> are further amended as follows.

(2) For the table at Regulation 4(1), substitute -

**Interpretation.**

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Driving Licences (Guernsey) Theory Test (Amendment) Regulations, 2015 and shall come into force on the 1st January, 2016.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Amendment Regulations amend the Driving Licences (Guernsey) Theory Test Regulations, 2005. The fees for a theory test have not been raised since July 2012. These Amendment Regulations increase the fee payable for a theory test, approximately in line with the Retail Price Index, from £35 to £38 for a motorcycle or motor car licence and from £50 to £54 for a goods or passenger vehicle licence.

The fee increase shall come into effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2016.
