

The Traffic Temporary (Rue de Bas) Regulations, 2016

Made

12th April, 2016

Coming into operation

1st June, 2016

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by article X of the Ordonnance relative au Trafic Vehiculaire en cette Ile, 1929^a and section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950^b, and of all powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in the localities of this Island referred to in these regulations:-

Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989^c, is amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph 2 in Part VIII of Schedule 1, the following paragraph –

"3. Rue de Bas. This paragraph applies only to vehicles of an overall width in excess of six feet, except for access to premises therein."

Interpretation.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**Department**" means the States Environment Department,

"**enactment**" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation, and

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^d applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(3) Unless the context requires otherwise, references in these Regulations to any enactment are references thereto as amended, varied, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Temporary (Rue de Bas) Regulations, 2016.

Commencement and Expiry

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st June, 2016 and cease to have effect -


(a) at the end of the period of 12 months commencing with the date on which they are made, or

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

This Regulation makes provision for the temporary introduction of a 6 feet (1.8m) width restriction for vehicles travelling along Rue de Bas, St. Sampson, except for those vehicles that need to gain access to premises, the intention being to reduce large vehicle movements and make it safer for pedestrians and cyclists.

These Regulations come into force on the 1st June, 2016.
