

**The Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical
Benefit) (Amendment) (No.3) Regulations, 2016**

THE SOCIAL SECURITY DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 10 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990 as amended^a, section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited Lists) Ordinance, 2004^b and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment.

1. In the Schedule to the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 2004^c, as amended remove the rows set out in the Schedule to these Regulations, under the appropriate headings.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^d applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

Citation, commencement and extent.

3. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment) (No.3) Regulations, 2016, and shall come into force on the 1st day of May 2016.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.
