

Ordinance of the Chief Pleas

entitled

The Deputies of the People (Bye-Election) Ordinance, 1985.

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section twelve of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951, hereby order:-

Date fixed
for bye-
election.

I.(1) An election for the office of Deputy of the People left vacant by the resignation of Mr. Lawrence Philip de Carteret shall be held on *Wednesday the 15th May* nineteen hundred and eighty five.

(2) In the event of two or more candidates at the said election securing an equal number of votes and by reason thereof a further election being required to be held in pursuance of the provisions of section five of the Election of Deputies (Sark) Ordinance, 1952, as amended, such further election shall be held on *Tuesday the 28th May* nineteen hundred and eighty five.

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Deputies of the People (Bye-Election) Ordinance, 1985
