## The Marriage Fees (Guernsey) Regulations, 2016

*Made* , 2016

*Coming into operation* 1st January, 2017

*Laid before the States* , 2017

**THE POLICY & RESOURCES COMMITTEE**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 5 of the Fees, Charges and Penalties (Guernsey) Law, 2007<sup>a</sup> as amended, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

### Amendment of fees.

1. For the schedule to the Marriage Fees (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1978<sup>b</sup>, substitute the schedule set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

### Repeal.

2. The Marriage Fees (Guernsey) Regulations, 2014<sup>c</sup> are repealed.

### Interpretation.

3. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

**"enactment"** means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation,  
and

**"subordinate legislation"** means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect.

(2) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

(3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>d</sup> applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

#### **Citation**

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Marriage Fees (Guernsey) Regulations, 2016.

#### **Commencement**

5. These Regulations shall come into force on 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2017.
