## The Liquor Licensing (Fees) (No. 2) (Sark) Ordinance, 1979

**THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section twenty-four of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951<sup>a</sup>, and with the approval of the Seigneur and in pursuance of their Resolution of the third day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order: –

### Fees for liquor licences.

1. The annual fees payable in respect of the categories of liquor licence which may be granted under the provisions of section 9 of the Liquor Licensing (General Provisions) (Sark) Ordinance, 1979, as amended (hereinafter called "**the Ordinance of 1979**") shall be as follows –

	<u>Category of licence</u>	<u>Fees per annum</u>
1.	Hotel Licence ... ..	£5.00 per bedroom in the hotel premises
2.	Public House Licence ... ..	[£200.00]
3.	General Off-Licence for the sale of intoxicating liquor for consumption off the licensed premises ... ..	[£200.00]
4.	Restaurant Licence ... ..	£50.00

**Initial payment for certain licences.**

**1A.** The fees payable on the grant of a Public House Licence and of a Club Licence pursuant to section 15(5) of the Liquor Licensing (General Provisions) (Sark) Ordinance, 1979, as amended, shall be as follows –

2.	Public House Licence ... ..	£500.00	
6.	Club Licence ... ..	£500.00]

**Fees for additional hours.**

2. The fees payable for permission granted under the provisions of section eighteen of the Ordinance of 1979 to exercise a liquor licence during hours in addition to those specified in Part II of the Ordinance of 1979 shall be [£3.00] for each hour or part of an hour during which the exercise of such liquor licence is permitted.

**Fees for unlicensed premises.**

3. The fees payable for permission granted under the provisions of section eighteen of the Ordinance of 1979 to exercise a liquor licence in premises in respect of which there is no liquor licence for the time being in force shall be [£3.00] for each hour or part of an hour during which the exercise of such licence is permitted:

Provided that not more than [£9.00] shall be payable in respect of any one day.

**Interpretation.**

4. (1) Any reference in this Ordinance to any other enactment shall, except where the context otherwise requires, be construed as including a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed or replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including this Ordinance.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>b</sup>, shall apply to the interpretation of this Ordinance as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

**Repeal.**

5. The Liquor Licensing (Fees) (Sark) Ordinance, 1979, is hereby repealed.

**Citation.**

6. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Fees) (No. 2) (Sark) Ordinance, 1979.

**Commencement.**

7. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty.
