**The Population Management  
(Resident Certificates and Permits) (Fees) Regulations,  
2017**

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 15 and 77 of the Population Management (Guernsey) Law, 2016<sup>a</sup>, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

**Fees payable on applications for Resident Certificates and Permits.**

1. (1) Subject to paragraphs (2) and (3), the fee payable on an application for a Resident Certificate or a Resident Permit is as set out in the Schedule.

(2) The Committee may publish policies providing for the payment of a fee in a lesser amount than that specified in the Schedule, or for the waiver of payment of a fee, in respect of applications for specified Resident Certificates and Resident Permits in specified circumstances.

(3) Where policies have been published by the Committee under paragraph (2), paragraph (1) and the Schedule shall be construed and applied in accordance with those policies.

(4) No fee payable under these Regulations is refundable.

**Interpretation.**

2. In these Regulations expressions have the meaning they have in the Population Management (Guernsey) Law, 2016.

**Citation.**

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Population Management (Resident Certificates and Permits) (Fees) Regulations, 2017.

**Commencement.**

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2017.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations prescribe the fees that are payable on applications for Resident Certificates and Resident Permits under the Population Management (Guernsey) Law, 2016. They provide for a lesser fee, or no fee, to be payable in circumstances set out in published policies of the Committee for Home Affairs.

These Regulations come into force on the 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2017.
