**The Immigration (Pakistan Act 1973) (Channel Islands and Isle
of Man) Order 1973**

Made - - - - - 27th July 1973
Coming into Operation 1st September 1973

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 27th day of July 1973

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 36 of the Immigration Act 1971(a), as extended by paragraph 1(3) of Schedule 3 to the Pakistan Act 1973(b), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Pakistan Act 1973) (Channel Islands and Isle of Man) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1973.

2. The provisions of paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to the Pakistan Act 1973 (transitional exemption from deportation), other than sub-paragraph (4) thereof, shall extend to the Bailiwick of Guernsey, to the Bailiwick of Jersey and to the Isle of Man, subject to the adaptations specified in the following Article.

3. Any reference in the said paragraph 1, as so extended, to a provision of the Immigration Act 1971 shall be construed as a reference to that provision as it has effect in the Bailiwick of Guernsey, in the Bailiwick of Jersey or, as the case may be, in the Isle of Man.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 7 of the Immigration Act 1971 affords certain Commonwealth citizens exemption from liability to deportation.

Paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to the Pakistan Act 1973 provides that a citizen of Pakistan who ceases to be a Commonwealth citizen by virtue of section 1(1) of that Act shall continue to enjoy the benefit of section 7 of the Act of 1971 for a period of twelve months or, if at the expiration of that period he is awaiting determination of an application for citizenship of the United Kingdom and Colonies, until the determination of his application.

This Order extends paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to the Act of 1973 to the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man.
