**The Traffic Temporary (Rue du Coudre) Regulations,
2017**

Made

13th April, 2017

Coming into operation

1st June, 2017

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordonnance relative au Trafic Vehiculaire en cette Ile, 1929^a and section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950^b, and of all powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating vehicular traffic in the locality of this Island referred to in these regulations:-

Amendments to 1989 Ordinance.

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989^c, as amended, is further amended as follows.

2. In Schedule 1, immediately after Part IX, insert -

"PART X

ST PIERRE DU BOIS

1. Rue du Coudre between its junction with Rue du Bordage and its junction with Rue du Camp au Prêtre, except for access to premises therein and animals, cycles or motorcycles."

Interpretation.

3. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**enactment**" includes a Law, an Ordinance and any subordinate legislation and includes any provision or portion of a Law, an Ordinance or any subordinate legislation, and

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any statutory, customary or inherent power and having legislative effect, but does not include an Ordinance.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^d applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(3) Unless the context requires otherwise, references in these Regulations to any enactment are references thereto as amended, varied, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Temporary (Rue du Coudre) Regulations, 2017.

Commencement and Expiry

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st June, 2017 and shall cease to have effect -

- (a) at the end of the period of 12 months commencing with the date on which they are made, or
- (b) on any earlier date determined by Order of the Department.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

This Regulation makes provision for the introduction, for an experimental period of 12 months, of a section of prohibited road at Route de Coudre. The intention is to limit traffic flows through the introduction of signs and the installation of traffic bollards at either end of a section of lane supported by a wall which is not a retaining structure. The prohibition will not apply to vehicles accessing premises, nor to animals, motorcycles or cycles.

These Regulations come into force on the 1st June, 2017.
