



**The Criminal Justice (Review of Notification
Requirements) (Bailiwick of Guernsey)
Regulations, 2017**

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 11(2) and 55 of the Criminal Justice (Sex Offenders and Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Law, 2013^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Prescribed form.

1. For the purposes of section 11(2) of the Criminal Justice (Sex Offenders and Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Law, 2013 ("the Law"), the prescribed form is the form set out in the Schedule.

Interpretation.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"enactment" includes a Law, an Ordinance and any subordinate

legislation and includes any provision or portion of a Law, an Ordinance or any subordinate legislation,

"subordinate legislation" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any statutory, customary or inherent power and having legislative effect, but does not include an Ordinance,

and other expressions have the same meanings as in the Law.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b applies to the interpretation of these Regulations throughout the Bailiwick of Guernsey.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation and commencement.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Review of Notification Requirements) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2017 and shall come into force on the 1st July, 2017.

Process Information
Upon submission of this application, you will receive acknowledgement of receipt from the Chief Officer of Police within 14 days. The Chief Officer will then review your application to decide whether to end your Notification Requirements under the Criminal Justice (Sex Offenders and Miscellaneous Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2013 ("the Law"). A written determination stating the Chief Officer's decision will be sent to you within 6 weeks of the date of the acknowledgement of receipt.
Your Responsibilities
Under section 12(2) of the Law, it is for <u>you</u> , the applicant, to show the Chief Officer of Police that it is not necessary to continue your Notification Requirements for the purpose of protecting the public, or any particular member of the public, from sexual harm. Although the Chief Officer will consider any other relevant information which may be provided by agencies such as Guernsey Police and the Probation Service, you should <u>not</u> assume that they will provide all of the information that you would like the Chief Officer to consider. If you intend to submit any further information or documents, please tick the box below and provide them within 14 days of the acknowledgement of receipt to the Chief Officer of Police, care of the MAPP Unit; any information or documents provided after this may not be considered.

I hereby confirm that I wish to submit this application to the Chief Officer of Police to review whether my Notification Requirements should be continued. I confirm that the details above are correct.
