


GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

**The Public Transport (Fees) (Guernsey)
Regulations, 2017**

<i>Made</i>	13th July, 2017
<i>Coming into operation</i>	1st August, 2017

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 5 of the Fees, Charges and Penalties (Guernsey) Law, 2007^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the Public Transport Ordinance, 1986.

1. (1) The Public Transport Ordinance, 1986^b is amended as follows.
 - (2) In section 12(1), for "£30" substitute "£40".
 - (3) In section 12(2), for "£10" substitute "£17".
 - (4) In section 12(3), for "£15" substitute "£17".

- (5) In section 14(3), for "£10" substitute "£20".
- (6) In section 42(6)(a), for "£20" substitute "£30".
- (7) In section 42(6)(c), for "£10" substitute "£15".

Amendment of the Permits to Drive Public Service Vehicles Ordinance, 1986.

2. (1) The Road Traffic (Permits to Drive Public Service Vehicles) Ordinance, 1986^c is amended as follows.

- (2) In section 4(4)(b), for "£20" substitute "£50".
- (3) In section 7 for "£10" substitute "£17".

Interpretation.

3. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**enactment**" includes a Law, an Ordinance and any subordinate legislation and includes any provision or portion of a Law, an Ordinance or any subordinate legislation, and

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any statutory, customary or inherent power and having legislative effect, but does not include an Ordinance..

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^d applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation and commencement.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Transport (Fees) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2017 and shall come into force on the 1st August, 2017.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations make provision for the increase of fees payable under the Public Transport Ordinance 1986 for -

- (a) the grant or renewal of public service vehicle licences;
- (b) the transfer of a public service vehicle licence;
- (c) the inspection of a public service vehicle; and

(d) the examination of a taximeter;

and also increase the fee payable for an Island knowledge test taken for the purposes of an application for a permit to drive a public service vehicle under the Road Traffic (Permits to Drive Public Service Vehicles) Ordinance, 1986, and the fee payable for the grant or renewal of such permits.

These Regulations come into force on the 1st day of August, 2017.
