**The Offences (Fixed Penalties)
(Guernsey) Order, 2017**


THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 5(1)(b), 7(3)(a) and 7(4)(b)(ii) of the Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey) Law, 2009^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Manner and place of fixed penalty payment.

1. (1) A fixed penalty must be paid –
 - (a) in cash,
 - (b) by cheque made payable to "States of Guernsey", or
 - (c) by debit or credit card.

- (2) Payment must be –

- (a) made over the internet using the "Fixed Penalty Notice" section of the payments portal of the States of Guernsey website (www.gov.gg/payit),
- (b) made (by debit or credit card) by telephoning Corporate Customer Services (01481 717003),
- (c) sent by post (cheques only) to Corporate Customer Services, Sir Charles Frossard House, La Charroterie, St Peter Port, Guernsey, GY2 1FH, or
- (d) delivered in person at the Corporate Customer Services Counter, Edward T. Wheadon House, Le Truchot, St Peter Port, Guernsey, GY1 3WH.

Revocation.

2. The Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey) Order, 2015^b is hereby revoked.

Interpretation.

3. (1) In this Order, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**enactment**" includes a Law, an Ordinance and any subordinate legislation and includes any provision or portion of a Law, an Ordinance or any subordinate legislation,

"**fixed penalty**" means a fixed penalty whose payment in accordance with the Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey) Law, 2009 discharges any liability to conviction of an offence particularised in a fixed penalty notice issued under section 2 of that Law, and

"subordinate legislation" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any statutory, customary or inherent power and having legislative effect, but does not include an Ordinance.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of this Order.

(3) Any reference in this Order to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation and commencement.

4. This Order may be cited as the Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey) Order, 2017 and shall come into force on the 16th September, 2017.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order specifies the manner in which, and the place at which, a fixed penalty is to be paid. This Order provides for payment in person to be made at Edward T Wheadon House, instead of Sir Charles Frossard House as at present; includes a reference to Corporate Customer Services as the agency to which such payments must be made; removes the reference to payment by postal order; and removes the requirement for a surcharge when paying by credit card. The equivalent Order made in 2015 is revoked.

This Order comes into force on the 16th day of September, 2017.
