## The Road Humps (Salerie Car Park)

**THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(5) of the

\* Road Traffic (Road Humps) (Guernsey) Law, 1983<sup>a</sup>, hereby orders:-

**Approval of road hump at Salerie car park.**

1. The retention of the road hump (raised table) constructed by the Committee for the Environment & Infrastructure on or about 18th October, 2016 across the public highway at Salerie car park, St Peter Port, is approved and embodied in this Order.

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) In this Order, unless the context requires otherwise -

"enactment" includes a Law, an Ordinance and any subordinate legislation and includes any provision or portion of a Law, an Ordinance or any subordinate legislation,

"subordinate legislation" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any statutory, customary or inherent power and having legislative effect, but does not include an Ordinance.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>b</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Order.

(3) Any reference in this Order to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

**Citation and commencement.**

3. This Order may be cited as the Road Humps (Salerie Car Park) Order, 2017 and shall come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2017.
