

**The Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List)
(Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment No. 4)
Regulations, 2017**

THE COMMITTEE FOR EMPLOYMENT & SOCIAL SECURITY, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 10 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990^a, section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited Lists) Ordinance, 2004^b and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment to the 2004 Regulations.

1. In the Schedule to the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 2004^c, as amended, insert the row set out in Schedule 1 to these Regulations in the appropriate place under the appropriate headings, as set out in that Schedule.

Interpretation.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^d applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

Citation, commencement and extent.

3. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment) (No.4) Regulations, 2017, and shall come into force on the 17th day of October 2017.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

These Regulations add to the limited list of drugs and medicines available as pharmaceutical benefit which may be ordered to be supplied by medical prescriptions issued by medical practitioners.

These Regulations come into force on the 17th October, 2017.

3.2	Corticosteroids	Beclometasone /Formoterol all strengths and presentations (Fostair)
3.4.2	Allergen immunotherapy	Omalizumab 150mg/ml pre-filled syringe (via Homecare delivery Company only)
10.1.3	Rheumatic Disease Suppressant	Baricitinab tab 2mg , 4mg (Third line use and via Homecare delivery Company only)
