**The Population Management
(Employment Permit Applications) (Amendment)
Regulations, 2017**

Made 30 October, 2017
Coming into operation 1st November, 2017
Laid before the States , 2017

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 21(3) and (8), and 77, of the Population Management (Guernsey) Law, 2016^a, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the Principal Regulations.

1. (1) The Population Management (Employment Permit Applications) Regulations, 2017^b are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 3(1)(b), for "four" substitute "eight".

Interpretation.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**enactment**" includes a Law, an Ordinance and any subordinate legislation and includes any provision or portion of a Law, an Ordinance or any subordinate legislation, and

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any statutory, customary or inherent power and having legislative effect, but does not include an Ordinance.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Population Management (Employment Permit Applications) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017.

Commencement.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st November, 2017.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations change the period in respect of which a standard late payment fee in respect of an application for an Employment Permit is payable, from between four and fourteen days after the relevant person commenced employment, to between eight and fourteen days after employment commenced.

These Regulations come into force on the 1st November, 2017.
