**The Health Service (Payment of Authorised Appliance  
Suppliers) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017**

THE COMMITTEE FOR EMPLOYMENT & SOCIAL SECURITY, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 19 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990<sup>a</sup>, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

**Amendment.**

1. The three Schedules to the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Appliance Suppliers) Regulations, 2003<sup>b</sup> are revoked and replaced by the three Schedules set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"enactment" includes a Law, an Ordinance and any subordinate legislation and includes any provision or portion of a Law, an Ordinance or any subordinate legislation,

"subordinate legislation" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any statutory, customary or inherent power and having legislative effect, but does not include an Ordinance,

and other expressions have the same meanings as in the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>c</sup> applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

#### **Revocation.**

3. The Health Service (Payment of Authorised Appliance Suppliers) (Amendment) Regulations, 2016<sup>d</sup> are revoked.

#### **Citation, commencement and extent.**

4. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Appliance Suppliers) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017, and shall come into force on the 1st January, 2018.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

On a non-business day, between 9am and 11pm, except whilst the premises are open for the purposes of any scheme prepared by the Authority under Part II of the Schedule to the Health Service (Authorised Appliance Suppliers) Regulations, 1990.	£30.55
On any day between 11pm and 9am of the next day or such earlier time at which the premises are opened for the supply of medical appliances (on any day except a non-business day).	£79.33

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## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations revoke and replace the Schedules to the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Appliance Suppliers) Regulations, 2003. The Schedules set out the payments which may be made out of the Guernsey Health Service Fund for the supply of medical appliances.

These Regulations come into force on the 1st January, 2018
