

ORDINANCE OF THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK

Ordinance No. III of 2018

The Conseillers (Tenure of Office) (Sark)

Ordinance, 2018

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 11th April, 2018, and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 23(2)(b) of the Reform (Sark) Law, 2008^a, hereby order:-

Dates of expiry of terms of office of present Conseillers.

1. (1) The date appointed for the purpose of section 23(2)(b) of the Reform (Sark) Law, 2008 in respect of the Conseillers elected pursuant to the general election on 10th December 2014, and any Conseiller subsequently elected to fill a vacancy amongst the Conseillers so elected, shall be 10th January, 2019.

(2) The date appointed for the purpose of section 23(2)(b) of the Reform (Sark) Law, 2008 in respect of the Conseillers elected pursuant to the general election on 14th December, 2016, and any Conseiller subsequently elected to fill a vacancy amongst the Conseillers so elected, shall be 14th January, 2021.

Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Ordinance -

"**enactment**" includes a Law, an Ordinance and any subordinate legislation and includes any provision or portion of a Law, an Ordinance or

any subordinate legislation,

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any statutory, customary or inherent power and having legislative effect, but does not include an Ordinance.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b applies to the interpretation of this Ordinance.

(3) Any reference in this Ordinance to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Conseillers (Tenure of Office) (Sark) Ordinance, 2018.
