


GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

**The Traffic Temporary (Belmont Road)
Regulations, 2018**

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950^a, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating vehicular traffic in this Island :-

Temporary amendment to 1989 Ordinance.

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989^b is amended by inserting, at the end of Part I of Schedule 1, the following additional paragraph –

"24. Belmont Road. This paragraph applies only to vehicles of an overall width in excess of six feet, except for access to premises therein."

Interpretation.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**Committee**" means the States Committee for the Environment & Infrastructure,

"**enactment**" includes a Law, an Ordinance and any subordinate legislation and includes any provision or portion of a Law, an Ordinance or any subordinate legislation,

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any statutory, customary or inherent power and having legislative effect, but does not include an Ordinance.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Temporary (Belmont Road) Regulations, 2018.

Commencement and expiry.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 22nd May, 2018 and shall cease to have effect –

- (a) at the end of the period of 12 months commencing with the date on which they are made, or
- (b) on any earlier date determined by Order of the Committee.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations make provision, for the temporary introduction of a 6 feet (1.82m) width restriction for vehicles travelling along Belmont Road, St Peter Port, except for those vehicles that need to gain access to premises, the intention being to reduce large vehicle movements and make it safer for pedestrians.

These Regulations come into force on the 22nd day of May, 2018.
