## The Public Records (Fees for Registration and Certified Copies of Documents) Regulations, 2018

THE POLICY & RESOURCES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 5 of the Fees, Charges and Penalties (Guernsey) Law, 2007<sup>a</sup>, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

### Registration fees for documents.

1. In section 1(a) of the Public Records (Fees for Registration and Certified Copies of Documents) Ordinance, 1960<sup>b</sup> ("the 1960 Ordinance"), for "£63" substitute "£66".

**Fees in respect of documents creating charge on land.**

2. In paragraphs (a) and (b) of section 2B of the 1960 Ordinance, for "£53" substitute "£56".

**Repeal.**

3. The Public Records (Fees for Registration and Certified Copies of Documents) Regulations, 2016<sup>c</sup> are repealed.

**Citation.**

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Records (Fees for Registration and Certified Copies of Documents) Regulations, 2018.

**Commencement.**

5. These Regulations shall come into force on 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2019.
