Orders of the Royal Court made in pursuance of Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948.

No. I ORDER, 1949, ENTITLED

“THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) (GUERNSEY)
REGULATIONS, 1945, AMENDMENT (ALDERNEY)
ORDER, 1949.”

WHEREAS by regulations 107 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, such of those Regulations as had then hitherto been applicable to

the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney were extended so as to apply (with certain modifications) to the Island of Alderney and the derivative acts continued, made, given or issued under those regulations and then hitherto applicable to the said Bailiwick excluding the Island of Alderney were extended so as to apply (with certain modifications) to the latter Island :

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the provisions of sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (3) of the said Regulation 107, in the application to the Island of Alderney of any such derivative act consisting of or containing the designation of any person as a competent Authority as respects the Bailiwick excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to any of the said Regulations, the President of the States of the Island of Alderney is, as respects that Island, deemed to have been designated as the competent Authority in relation to that Regulation :

AND WHEREAS by such a derivative act the President of the States of Guernsey Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities has been designated as a Competent Authority in relation to Regulation 55 of the said Regulations as respects the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and the President of the States of Alderney is accordingly the Competent Authority in relation to that Regulation as respects the Island of Alderney :

AND WHEREAS it is expedient at the request of the States of Alderney to substitute the President of the Alderney Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities for the President of the States of Alderney as the Competent Authority in relation to that Regulation as respects the Island of Alderney :

NOW THEREFORE the Royal Court, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by virtue of the

provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Guernsey) Order in Council, 1946, as varied by Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders that :—

1. The President of the Alderney Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities shall be the Competent Authority in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, as respects the Island of Alderney in the place and stead of the President of the States of Alderney.

2. In paragraph 1 of this Order, the expression “ the President of the Alderney Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities ” shall include any member of that Committee from time to time acting as President of that Committee.

3. This Order shall commence to have effect on the 1st day of August, 1949, and shall be transmitted by H.M. Greffier to the Clerk of the Court of Alderney for registration on the records of the latter Island.
