THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) (GUERNSEY)
REGULATIONS, 1945, AMENDMENT
(No. 1) ORDER, 1950.

The Royal Court, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Guernsey) Order in Council, 1946, and of the Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Order in Council, 1947, and of Article 64 of the Reform

(Guernsey) Law, 1948, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:—

1. Regulations 22, 43, 44A and 45 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, are hereby revoked.

2. The Ordinance directing that certain Defence Regulations shall have effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945, as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey, of the 16th day of February, 1946, (hereinafter referred to as “the 1946 Ordinance”) is hereby amended by deleting, in the First Schedule thereto, in the first column of that Schedule, the figures and letter “43”, “44A” and “45”, and in the second column thereof, the words “General control of navigation.”, “Power to exclude British ships from particular areas.” and “Measures for safety of British ships.”.

3. The Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions Continuance) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1947, (hereinafter referred to as “the 1947 Ordinance”) is hereby amended by deleting, in Part I of the Schedule thereto, in the first column of that Schedule, the word and figures “Regulation 22”, and in the second column thereof, the word “(Billeting).”.

4. Copies of the Order shall be transmitted to the Court of Alderney and the Seneschal of the Island of Sark for registration on the Records of those Islands respectively.

5. This Order shall come into force on the 25th day of March, 1950.
