The Royal Court, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provi-

sions) (Guernsey) Order in Council, 1952, and in pursuance of Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, hereby orders:—

1. Regulation forty-fiveA of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945 (which empowers the Competent Authority to make provision by order for the issue of identity cards to seamen) is hereby revoked.

2. Copies of this Order shall be transmitted by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Court of Alderney and the Seneschal of Sark for registration on the respective Records of those Islands.
