

ORDER OF THE ROYAL COURT MADE IN
PURSUANCE OF THE SUPPLIES AND
SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(GUERNSEY) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1946,

ENTITLED

**The Defence (General) (Guernsey)
Regulations, 1945, Amendment (No. 1)
Order, 1954.**

The Royal Court, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Guernsey) Order in Council,

1946, and in pursuance of Article sixty-four of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:—

1. Paragraph (1D) and paragraph (1E) of Regulation fifty-five of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945 (which impose special penalties on persons convicted of offences against that Regulation) are hereby revoked except in relation to persons against whom proceedings for offences against that Regulation have been commenced before the date of the coming into operation of this Order.
2. Regulation ninety of the said Regulations (which penalises persons who attempt, or conspire, to commit offences against those Regulations or who assist other persons with intent thereby to prevent the apprehension, trial or punishment of those other persons for such offences) is hereby revoked except in relation to persons against whom proceedings have, by virtue of that Regulation, been commenced before the coming into operation of this Order.
3. Copies of this Order shall be transmitted by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Court of Alderney and the Seneschal of Sark for registration on the respective Records of those Islands.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-seventh day of March, 1954.
