THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers
conferred on it by virtue of the Supplies and Services

(Transitional Powers) (Guernsey) Order in Council, 1946, and in pursuance of Article sixty-four of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:—

1. Regulation fifty-one of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945 (which relates to the taking of possession of land) is hereby revoked.

2. The Third Schedule to Regulation one hundred and six of the aforesaid Regulations, as amended, is hereby further amended by the deletion in column one of the Table contained in that Schedule of the reference to Regulation 51.

3. Copies of this Order shall be transmitted by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Court of Alderney and the Seneschal of Sark for registration on the respective Records of those Islands.

4. This Order shall come into force on the sixth day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
