The Social Insurance (Reciprocal Agreement with New Zealand) Ordinance, 1995

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 113 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended(a), hereby order:-

Convention to have effect

1. (1) The Agreement on Social Security between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of New Zealand, signed at London on the 3rd November, 1994, and registered on the records of this Island on 31st January, 1995 shall have full force and effect.

(2) The Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended, shall have effect subject to such modifications as may be required for the purpose of giving effect to the said Agreement.

Extent

2. This Ordinance shall apply to the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Social Insurance (Reciprocal Agreement with New Zealand) Ordinance, 1995.

Commencement

4. This Ordinance shall commence on the 1st day of April, 1995.
