The Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Food and Drugs) Ordinance, 1971

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948^a, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order: –

Law of 1970 to have effect in Alderney.

1. The Food and Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1970^b [as amended by the Food and Drugs (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1975,] [the Food and Drugs (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1995 and the Food and Drugs (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1996,] other than section fifty-five thereof in so far as that section repeals the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport aux Préservatifs et autres substances dans les Aliments" registered on the twenty-third day of February, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine^c, shall, subject to the exceptions, adaptations and modifications set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance, have effect in the Island of Alderney as it has effect in the Island of Guernsey.

the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Food and Drugs) Ordinance, 1997, section 2, with effect from 24th September, 1997.¹

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Food and Drugs) Ordinance, 1971.

Commencement.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

REPEALED

1. In sections forty-seven, forty-eight and fifty-six the words "the States", wherever those words occur, are deleted and the words "the States of Guernsey" are substituted therefor.

2. In sections four, nine, twenty-four and fifty the words "the Magistrate's Court", wherever those words occur, are deleted and the words "the Court of Alderney" are substituted therefor.

3. In sections thirteen, fourteen and forty-six the words "the Royal Court", wherever those words occur, are deleted and the words "the Court of Alderney" are substituted therefor.

4. In subsection (2) of section eighteen immediately after the word "Advocate" there are inserted the words "of the Royal Court of the Island of Guernsey".

5. In section thirty-one the words "the Bailiff", wherever those words occur, are deleted and the words "the Chairman of the Court of Alderney" are substituted therefor.

6. In subsection (1) of section fifty-four –

[(a) the definition of the expression "authorised medical practitioner" is deleted and the following definition is substituted therefor –

" **"authorised medical practitioner"** means a medical practitioner authorised to practise as such in Alderney according to the law for the time being in force,".]

- (b) the definition of the expression "the Bailiff" shall be omitted,
- (c) in the definition of the expression "the Board" immediately after the word "States" there are inserted the words "of Guernsey",
- (d) in the definition of the expression "business" the word "States" shall be construed as including a reference to the States of Alderney,
- (e) the definition of the expression "the Island" is deleted and the following definition is substituted therefor –
- " **"the Island"** means the Island of Alderney,"
- (f) the definition of the expression "Medical Officer of Health" shall be construed as including a reference to the person for the time being exercising in Alderney the functions of a Medical Officer of Health,
- (g) the definition of the expression "Royal Court" is deleted and the following definition is substituted therefor –
- " **"Royal Court"** means the Royal Court of Guernsey sitting as a Full Court,".]
