The Fort Le Marchant Rifle Range (Firing on Sunday 15th May 1988) Ordinance, 1988

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 17th day of March, 1988, hereby order: –

Firing of firearms on Sunday 15th May, 1988.

1. Notwithstanding special condition (a) 1 in Part III of Schedule 1 to the Firearms Ordinance, 1987^a, the States of Guernsey [Committee for Education, Sport & Culture] is hereby authorised to permit the firing of firearms at the Fort Le Marchant Rifle Range on Sunday 15th May 1988.

NOTES

In section 1, the words in square brackets were substituted by the Organisation of States' Affairs (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 2016, section 2, Schedule 1, paragraph 2(a), with effect from 1st May, 2016.¹

The functions, rights and liabilities of the Culture and Leisure Department and of its Minister or Deputy Minister arising under or by virtue of this Ordinance were transferred to and vested in, respectively, the Committee for Education, Sport & Culture and its President or Vice-President by the Organisation of States' Affairs (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 2016, section 1, Schedule 1, paragraph 2(a), with effect from 1st May, 2016, subject to the savings and transitional provisions in section 3 of the 2016 Ordinance.²

Construction.

2. This Ordinance shall be construed as one with the Firearms Ordinance, 1987.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fort Le Marchant Rifle Range (Firing on Sunday 15th May 1988) Ordinance, 1988.
