

The Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 2019

24th January, 2019

Coming into operation

3rd February, 2019

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1 of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963^a, hereby orders:-

Amendments to 1991 Order.

1. The Parking Places Order, 1991^b is amended as follows.

2. In Part C of Schedule 1, in the third column of the entry relating to disc parking place No. DC49 –
 - (a) for "west" substitute "east",

 - (b) at the end, insert "between 10.00 on Monday to Saturday and 1.00 on the next day following, and all day on a Sunday or a public holiday".

3. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 2019 and shall come into force on the 3rd February, 2019.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Parking Places Order, 1991 as part of a larger project to improve pedestrian safety. It removes the two accessible disc parking spaces for holders of a blue badge from outside Creasey's in Le Petit Carrefour in St Peter Port, and relocates them to the market side of the road. The Order also restricts such parking to the times specified, in order to allow for unloading of goods in the area.

This Order comes into force on the 3rd day of February, 2019.
