

The Health and Safety (Fees) Order, 2019

THE COMMITTEE FOR EMPLOYMENT & SOCIAL SECURITY, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 3 of the Health and Safety (Fees) (Guernsey) Law, 1993^a, section 3(4) and (5) of the Public Highways Ordinance, 1967^b and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby order:-

Fees payable under Explosives Law.

1. (1) The table below specifies the fees payable under and for the purposes of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Explosifs, 1905"^c ("the 1905 Law").

* Major hazard site means the whole location where a dangerous substance is present, in a quantity equal to or in excess of the quantity listed in the entry for that substance in column 2 of Part 1 or in column 2 of Part 2 of Schedule 1 to the Control of Major Accident Hazard Regulations 2015^h, where applicable using the rule laid down in note 4 in Part 3 of that schedule.

Fees payable under Public Highways Ordinance.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order specifies the fees payable to the States of Guernsey Health and Safety Executive under and for the purposes of the Law entitled “Loi relative aux Explosifs, 1905”, the Law entitled “Loi relative aux Huiles ou Essences Minerales ou autre substances de la meme nature, 1924”, the Health, Safety and Welfare of Employees Law, 1950 and the Health and Safety at Work etc. (Guernsey) Law, 1979 (including the Ordinance thereunder).

This Order also enables the recovery of costs for contracted-out work required when regulating major hazard sites.

This Order also specifies, under the Public Highways Ordinance, 1967, fees payable for scaffolding, hoarding and banner permits granted under that Ordinance.

This Order comes into force on the 1st day of June, 2019.
