**The Road Traffic (Construction and Use) (Exemptions)
Regulations, 2019**

7th March, 2019

Coming into operation

29th March, 2019

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 9I of the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinance, 2002^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Exemption to speedometer requirement.

1. Section 9I(1) of the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinance, 2002 does not apply to -

- (a) an agricultural motor vehicle which is not driven at more than 20 miles per hour,
- (b) a motorcycle first used before 1st April 1984, the engine of which has a cylinder capacity not exceeding 100 cc,

(c) a works truck first used before 1st April, 1984, and

(d) a vehicle first used before 1st October, 1937.

Interpretation.

2. In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**agricultural motor vehicle**" means a vehicle used primarily off roads in connection with agricultural, horticultural, market gardening and forestry,

"**first used**" means -

(a) in the case of a vehicle which is registered, the date on which it was first registered, whether in Guernsey or elsewhere,

(b) in the case of a vehicle which is not registered, the date of manufacture,

"**motorcycle**" means any two-wheeled motor vehicle, with or without a side-car,

"**straddle carrier**" means a motor vehicle constructed to straddle and lift its load for the purpose of transportation,

"**works truck**" means a motor vehicle (other than a straddle carrier) designed for use in private premises and used on a road only in delivering goods from or to such premises to or from a vehicle on a road in the immediate neighbourhood, or in passing from one part of any such premises to another

or to other private premises in the immediate neighbourhood, or in connection with road works while at or in the immediate neighbourhood of the site of such works.

Citation and commencement.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Construction and Use) (Exemptions) Regulations, 2019 and shall come into force on the same day as the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2019.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations make for exemptions from the requirement, in section 9I of the Road Traffic (Construction and Use) Ordinance, 2002, that motor vehicles capable of exceeding 25 miles per hour must be fitted with a speedometer.

These Regulations come into force on the same day as the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2019, which inserted the requirement into the 2002 Ordinance.
