



**The Customs and Cross-Border Trade (General and
Enabling Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018
(Commencement) Regulations, 2019**

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 9 and 14 of the Customs and Cross-Border Trade (General and Enabling Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Commencement of the Law.

1. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the Customs and Cross-Border Trade (General and Enabling Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018 ("**the Law**") shall come into force on exit day; and for the purposes of these Regulations, "**exit day**" has the meaning given in the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018^b.

(2) Section 11(1) of the Law shall come into force on 29th March 2019 to the extent necessary to bring into force the following provisions of Schedule 1 to the

Law –

- (a) paragraph 1(2)(c), and
- (b) paragraphs 1(3), (7), (10), (15), (16) and (17).

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Cross-Border Trade (General and Enabling Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018 (Commencement) Regulations, 2019.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations bring into force the Customs and Cross-Border Trade (General and Enabling Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018 ("the Law") in two stages. Most of the Law is brought into force on "exit day" within the meaning of the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018, but certain amendments to the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972 in Schedule 1 to the Law are brought into force on 29th March 2019.
