



**The Customs and Excise
(Approved Ports and Customs Declarations)
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2019**

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 15 and 79 of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of Approved Ports and Customs Declarations Regulations.

1. (1) The Customs and Excise (Approved Ports and Customs Declarations) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2019^b are amended as follows.

(2) Regulation 1 is revoked.

(3) After Regulation 2(2)(b), insert –

"(ba) the goods are subject to a relief for the purpose of import duty under paragraph (3) of the Schedule to the Customs and Excise (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Personal Reliefs) Order 2008,".

Citation and commencement.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Approved Ports and Customs Declarations) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2019 and shall come into force on exit day; and for these purposes, "exit day" has the meaning given in the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018^c.
