



**The Customs and Excise
(Approved Ports) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2019**

Made

1st April, 2019

Coming into operation

See article 2

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 7 and 79 of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

Appointment of ports and airports.

1. (1) The appointment of the ports specified in Schedule 1 as ports for the purposes of customs and excise shall continue.

(2) The appointment of the aerodromes specified in Schedule 2 as customs airports for the purposes of customs and excise shall continue.

Citation and commencement.

2. This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Approved Ports)
