**The Terrorist Asset Freezing (Designations) (Brexit)
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2019**

THE POLICY & RESOURCES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 5(1) and 11 of the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018^a, and upon receipt of the certificate required under section 5(3) of that Law, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of Terrorist Asset Freezing Law.

1. In section 1 of the Terrorist Asset Freezing (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2011^b, after subsection (a) insert –

"(ab) a person who is subject to a designation under and within the meaning of the Counter-Terrorism (International Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019,".



Citation and commencement.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Terrorist Asset Freezing (Designations) (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2019, and come into force on the day on which they are made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made in consequence of the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the EU. They amend the definition of "designated person" at section 1 of the Terrorist Asset Freezing (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2011, which specifies the categories of person who are subject to terrorist asset freezing provisions, to include persons designated by the United Kingdom under the Counter-Terrorism (International Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019. This will ensure that any such designations will have effect immediate effect in the Bailiwick as soon as they are made.
