THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1 of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963^a, hereby orders:-

Amendments to 1991 Order.

1. The Parking Places Order, 1991^b is amended as follows.
2. In Part C of Schedule 1, in the entry relating to disc parking place No. DC24a, delete ", but excluding Approved Parking Place No. AD8".
3. In Part C of Schedule 2 –
 - (a) the entries relating to approved parking places Nos. AC3 and AC9 are deleted,


- (b) in the third column of the entry relating to approved parking place No. AC8, for "Commercial Road" substitute "Bridge Avenue",
- (c) in the third column of the entry relating to approved parking place No. AC9a, delete "immediately to the east of the pedestrian crossing,"
- (d) in the third column of the entry relating to approved parking place No. AC22, for "146" substitute "143".

4. In Part D of Schedule 2, the entries relating to approved parking places Nos. AD5 and AD8 are deleted.

Citation and commencement.

5. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2019 and shall come into force on the 5th May, 2019.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Parking Places Order, 1991 so as to –

(a) remove an accessible parking space for blue badge holders, and an approved parking place for taxis, from the North Plantation, as part of a project to enhance road safety in the area for pedestrians and facilitate al fresco dining,

(b) re-locate two accessible parking spaces for blue badge holders at the Bridge in St Sampson's,

(c) remove an approved parking place for taxis from the marina side of the Bridge so as to add two two-hour disc parking spaces in that area,

(d) re-locate the accessible parking space for blue badge holders opposite the clock tower at South Quay in St Sampson's to a position nearer the shops, and

(e) re-locate an accessible parking space for blue badge holders to a different position at Les Genats Estate, in accordance with requirements.

This Order comes into force on the 5th day of May, 2019.
