



## **The Traffic Temporary (North Plantation and Rue à l'Or) Regulations, 2019**

*Made*

*15<sup>th</sup> April, 2019*

*Coming into operation*

*5<sup>th</sup> May, 2019*

**THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950<sup>a</sup>, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in the localities referred to in these Regulations:-

### **Amendments to 1989 Ordinance.**

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989<sup>b</sup> ("the 1989 Ordinance") is amended as follows.

2. In entry number 21 in Part I of Schedule 1 of the 1989 Ordinance, for the words from "This paragraph" to the end, substitute: "This paragraph does not apply between the hours of 5 a.m. and 10 a.m., for the purpose of loading or unloading."

3. Immediately after entry number 24 in Part I of Schedule 1 of the 1989 Ordinance, insert the following –

"25. Rue à l'Or: This paragraph only applies to the section between Richmond Avenue and Le Vauquiedor, except for access to premises therein and cycles."

**Citation.**

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Temporary (North Plantation and Rue à l'Or) Regulations, 2019.

**Commencement and expiry.**

5. These Regulations come into force on the 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2019 and cease to have effect –

- (a) at the end of the period of 12 months commencing with the said date, or
- (b) on any earlier date determined by order of the Committee for the Environment & Infrastructure.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These temporary Regulations amend the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance 1989 so as -

(a) in relation to the prohibited street at North Plantation, to permit access only for the purpose of loading and unloading between the hours of 5 a.m. and 10 a.m. (access for other purposes will be allowed by permit only), as part of a project to enhance the area for pedestrians and facilitate al fresco dining,

(b) to prohibit access to the section of Rue à l'Or between Richmond Avenue and Le Vauquiedor, except for access to premises and cycles, to reduce vehicular movements with the aim of improving road safety, primarily for pedestrians and cyclists.

These Regulations come into force on the 5th day of May, 2019 and will have effect for 12 months.
