The Control of Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places) (Muratti Vase Football Final) Order 2019

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 2(1) and (2) of the Control of Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places) Ordinance, 2007^a, amended hereby orders:-

1. In order to prevent nuisance or annoyance to members of the public or a section of the public or disorder which is likely to be associated with the consumption of intoxicating liquor in that place, the area of the Parish of St Peter Port marked in red on the attached plan, that is:-

- (a) Footes Lane from the junction with the Rohais de Bas and Rue des Varendes to its junction with Les Baissieres:

shall be a designated public place for the purpose of the Control of Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places) Ordinance, 2007 between 11a.m. and 6 p.m. on Saturday 18th May 2019.

2. This Order may be cited as the Control of Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places) (Muratti Vase football Final) Order 2019 and shall come into force on the 18th May 2019.
