**The Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor
Vehicles) (Guernsey) (Brexit) Regulations, 2019**

THE POLICY & RESOURCES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 5(1) and 11 of the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018^a, and upon receipt of the certificate required under section 5(3) of that Law, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment to 2002 Ordinance.

1. In section 13(1) of the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinance, 2002^b, immediately after "this Ordinance" insert "or the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1971".

Extent.

2. These Regulations have effect in Guernsey.



Citation and commencement.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) (Guernsey) (Brexit) Regulations, 2019 and shall come into force on the 24th day of April, 2019.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made in consequence of the proposed withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the EU and the resulting necessity for the ratification on behalf of Guernsey of the Vienna Convention on Road Traffic 1968. The Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2019, made on 15th January, 2019, amended (inter alia) the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1971 ("the 1971 Ordinance") so as to introduce enhanced requirements for the construction and use of motor vehicles in order to comply with the provisions of the Vienna Convention. These Regulations amend the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinance, 2002 so as to clarify that the "Offences and Penalties" provision in that Ordinance also applies to the 1971 Ordinance, thereby facilitating the enforcement of the new requirements.

These Regulations will come into force on the 24th April, 2019.
