**THE COMMITTEE FOR EMPLOYMENT & SOCIAL SECURITY**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 10 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990<sup>a</sup> and section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited Lists) Ordinance, 2004<sup>b</sup>, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

**Citation, commencement and extent.**

2. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations, 2019, and shall come into force on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of July, 2019.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

British National Formulary (BNF) Section	Heading	Pharmaceutical Benefit
5.3	Antivirals	Vosevi 400mg/100mg/100mg tablets (To be prescribed by local Consultant Virologist and to be dispensed by the PEH Pharmacy only)
6.1.2	Antidiabetic drugs	Semaglutide 1mg/0.74ml solution for injection 3ml pre-filled pen ; 0.5mg/0.37ml solution for injection 1.5ml pre-filled pen; 0.25mg/0.19ml solution for injection 1.5ml pre-filled pen (First line GLP-1 agonist)
2.8	Anticoagulants and protamine	Edoxaban 15mg, 30mg, 60mg tablets (To be prescribed according to treatment protocol)

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations add a number of drugs to the list of drugs that may be prescribed as pharmaceutical benefit.

These Regulations come into force on the 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2019.
