



The Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment No. 5) Regulations, 2019

THE COMMITTEE FOR EMPLOYMENT & SOCIAL SECURITY, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 10 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990^a and section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited Lists) Ordinance, 2004^b, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment to the 2004 Regulations.

1. In the Schedule to the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 2004^c ("the Schedule") –

- (b) substitute the entries relating to Melatonin in the rows of the Schedule referred to in columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 2 to these Regulations for the appropriate entries set out in column 3 of Schedule 2 to these Regulations.

Citation, commencement and extent.

2. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment No. 5) Regulations, 2019, and shall come into force on the 28th day of August, 2019.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

ROWS TO BE SUBSTITUTED IN THE SCHEDULE TO THE 2004 REGULATIONS

British National Formulary (BNF) Section	Heading	Pharmaceutical Benefit
4.4.1	Hypnotics	Melatonin oral suspension 10mg/5ml
4.4.1	Hypnotics	Melatonin modified release tablets 2mg: to be prescribed or initiated only by CAMHS consultants, MSG, or a Learning Disability Specialist for people with learning disabilities.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations add a drug to the list of drugs that may be prescribed as pharmaceutical benefit, substitute one drug on that list with another form of the same drug, and enable a drug already on the list to be prescribed by a Learning Disability Specialist for people with learning disabilities.

These Regulations come into force on the 28th August, 2019.
