**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bailiwick of
Guernsey) Alderney Royal Aero Club Air Racing
Regulations, 2019**

THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL AVIATION, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 35(1)(b) of the Air Navigation (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012^a and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations: -

Restriction of flying and access to Alderney Airport.

1. The airspace having lateral limits of a circle radius of 8 nautical miles centred on the Air Race datum, Alderney (N 049 42.22 W 002 12.53) and vertical limits of the surface to 2,500 feet Above Mean Sea Level ("AMSL") is classified as Restricted Airspace on the following dates and times:

Saturday 21 st September 2019	from 1045 until 1200 hours UTC
	from 1500 until 1630 hours UTC

Sunday 22nd September 2019

from 0915 until 1045 hours UTC

from 1330 until 1500 hours UTC

2. Alderney Airport shall be closed during the dates and times specified in regulation 1 to all aircraft except those mentioned in regulation 3(2).

3. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), no aircraft shall, from 1045 until 1210 hours (UTC) and from 1500 until 1630 hours (UTC) on Saturday 21st September 2019 and from 0915 until 1045 hours (UTC) and from 1330 until 1500 hours (UTC) on Sunday 22nd September 2019, fly into the airspace below 2,500 feet AMSL within a radius of eight nautical miles from position:

N 049 42.22

W 002 12.53

(2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to -

- (a) any aircraft flying with the permission of the Manager, Air Traffic Control Guernsey, exercised through the ATC Watch Supervisor at Guernsey Approach Control,
- (b) any aircraft at Alderney engaged in Royal Aero Club air racing, race practice or race GPS calibration, or
- (c) any aircraft flying for the purpose of Search and Rescue or for the purpose of saving life.


Interpretation.

4. All times referred to in these Regulations are Universal Time Coordinated (UTC).

Citation and commencement.

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Alderney Royal Aero Club Air Racing Regulations, 2019 and shall come into force on Saturday 21st September, 2019.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These regulations prohibit (subject to the granting of exemptions) all flights within eight nautical miles of position:

N 049 42.22

W 002 12.53

during the times stated by reason of air racing, race practice and race GPS calibration. They impose other restrictions on flying and the use of Alderney Airport in order to enable the event to be undertaken safely.
