ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

1. "Acte de permis évoquer".
2. "The appointed manner".

(Made on the 2nd March, 1940.)

[Ordonnance par rapport à la Publication des Annonces Officielles (1940)]

LA COUR, ouïes les conclusions des Officiers du Roi, a ordonné et ordonne comme suit, savoir: –

"Acte de permis évoquer".

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 4 of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance par rapport à la Publication des Annonces Officielles" dated the 21st day of March, 1936, and hereinafter referred to as "**the principal Ordinance**", the publication in the appointed manner of an "Acte de permis évoquer" on one occasion, instead of on two occasions as heretofore, shall henceforth be a sufficient publication thereof.

Provided that no proceedings following upon the publication of an "Acte de permis évoquer" shall be taken until after the expiration of the seven days next following the date of the publication of that "Acte".

NOTE

In accordance with the provisions of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, Article 70(3), with effect from 1st January, 1950, this formerly Provisional Ordinance of the Royal Court became a Permanent Ordinance of the States.

In accordance with the provisions of the Official Publications Ordinance, 1950, section 2, with effect from 19th April, 1950, this Ordinance may be cited as the Official Publications Ordinance, 1940.

In accordance with the provisions of the Official Publications (Amendment) Ordinance, 1973, section 3, with effect from 3rd December, 1973, this Ordinance, when cited together with the Ordonnance par rapport à la Publication des Annonces Officielles, 1936 (the "Official Publications Ordinance, 1936"), the Official Publications Ordinance, 1948, the Official Publications (Amendment) Ordinance, 1965 and the 1973 Ordinance, may be cited as the Official Publications Ordinances, 1936 to 1973.¹

"The appointed manner".

2. In this Ordinance the expression "**the appointed manner**" is to be construed in accordance with the provisions of the principal Ordinance.

NOTE

The Ordinance was made and came into operation on 2nd March, 1940.
