*In accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic (Drink Driving) (Guernsey) Law, 1989, section 2A(7), Schedule, with effect from 29th March, 2004, offences under this Ordinance constitute "traffic offences" for the purposes of the 1989 Law.*

### Brakes.

**Mirrors.**

"S" 4. Every motor vehicle other than a motorcycle, when on a public highway, shall be equipped either internally or externally with a mirror so constructed and fitted to the motor vehicle as to assist the driver to become aware of traffic at the rear of the vehicle.

**Windscreens.**

"S" 5. Where a motor vehicle equipped with a windscreen for the protection of the driver is on a public highway –

- (a) the windscreen shall be free from defects which impair its transparency,
- (b) the vehicle shall be fitted with an efficient automatic windscreen wiper, properly adjusted and in good working order,
- (c) when the vehicle is in motion, so much of the windscreen as is necessary to afford to the driver an adequate view to the front of the vehicle shall be constantly kept in such condition as to afford to the driver such adequate view.
